



DESCRIPTION:

Nonwoven Geotextile is made of polyester, needle-punched and calendered. Its primary functions include;

- Filtration acts as a sand filter by allowing water to move through the soil while retaining all upstream soil particles.
- Separation acts to separate two layers of soil that have different particle size distributions.
- Protection acts as anti-puncturing protection and preventing local damage on exposed waterproofing membranes.
